2011 ANNUAL REPORT

The year was filled with both opportunities and challenges. Some highlights were:

- Implemented two large-scale educational programs for healthcare professionals on clinical advances in asthma care
- Implemented a data conference to share the latest Illinois and Chicago-focused asthma research
- Completed a community health survey in three underserved communities in Chicago that will allow Chicago Asthma Consortium and other organizations to better serve the residents in the communities and to reduce health disparities
- Disseminated “Asthma First Aid” posters to all Chicago Public Schools to assist staff in recognizing and responding to an asthma emergency
- Distributed 26 Asthma Friendly School Awards
- Served in a coordination role for several area grants including the *Healthy Home Healthy Child: The Westside Children’s Asthma Partnership* grant, and the *CDC Improving Health and Educational Outcomes of Young People* grant
- Maintained a comprehensive, searchable community health clinic list on the Chicago Asthma Consortium website
